**THE PUNJAB CATTLE FAIRS (REGULATION) AMENDMENT  
ACT, 2014**

**(Punjab Act No. 10 of 2015)**

ACT

*further to amend the Punjab Cattle Fairs (Regulation) Act, 1967.*

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Sixty-fifth Year of the Republic of India, as follows :-

**1.** (1) This Act may be called the Punjab Cattle Fairs (Regulation) Amendment Act, 2014. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force on and with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

**2.** In the Punjab Cattle Fairs (Regulation) Act, 1967, in section 2, in clause (b), the word and sign "elephant," shall be omitted. Amendment in section 2 of Punjab Act 6 of 1968.

**No. G.S.R. 6/C.A.67/1957/S.23-C/Amd.(4)/2015.**-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 and section 23-C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013, namely:-

**RULES**

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Punjab Minor Mineral (Amendment) Rules, 2015.

(2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. 1) In the Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 (here in after referred to as the said rules), for rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted namely:-

**"3 Exemptions. –**

(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, no rent, royalty or permit fee shall be charged or no permit/weightment slip shall be required for-

- (i) extraction of ordinary clay and ordinary sand by hereditary 'Ghumriars', who prepare earthen pots on a cottage industry basis, whose turnover during a year does not exceed two lac rupees;
- (ii) leveling of any agricultural fields by the land owner or possessor, as the case may be and disposal of any excess minor mineral accumulated in such activity;
- (iii) for removal of any minor mineral by the land owner or the possessor/Panchayat as the case may be, from the land in their possession for meeting land-filling requirements either

in another agricultural field owned or possessed by them or for meeting their bona-fide/personal requirements including Religious and developmental activities.

3. In the said rules, after rule 13, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

**"13A:** Mining lease given to set up a mineral based Industry in the State of Punjab shall be for the captive use only and the lessee shall not sell any unprocessed minor mineral from the area under mining lease. Any other incidental minor mineral shall be sold only after approval of Director, Mining".

**No.G.S.R.7/Const./Art.309/Amd.(15)/2015.**-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Civil Services (General and Common Conditions of Service) Rules, 1994, namely :-

**RULES**

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Civil Services (General and Common Conditions of Service) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2015.  
(2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Punjab Civil Services (General and Common Conditions of Service) Rules, 1994 (hereinafter to as the said rules), after rule 14, the following rule shall be inserted namely :-

"14A. Minimum Educational and other Qualifications for appointment to the post of Senior Assistant by –

<b>Direct Appointment</b>	<b>Promotion</b>
No person shall be given direct appointment to the post of Senior Assistant under the Punjab Government, unless he –  (i) Possesses the Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University or Institution; and  (ii) Qualifies in the competitive test specified by the appointing authority from time to time ; and	From amongst the clerks, who have an experience of working as such for a minimum period of five years.

(iii) Possesses at least one hundred and twenty hours course with hands on experience in the use of Personal Computer or Information Technology in Office Productivity applications or Desktop Publishing applications from a Government recognised institution or a reputed institution, which is ISO 9001, certified.

OR

Possesses a Computer Information Technology Course equivalent to 'O' level certificate of Department of Electronics Accreditation of Computer Course (DOEACC) of Government of India.

(2) The person so appointed as Senior Assistant in terms of the Provisions of sub-rule (1), shall have, before his appointment, qualified a test in Punjabi typewriting on Computer to be conducted by the Board or the appointing authority or the Department of Information Technology, as the case may be, at a speed of thirty words per minute :

Provided that where appointment of Group 'B' non-technical post is offered to a War Hero, who has been discharged from Defence Services or dependent member of his family under the instructions issued in this behalf by the Government, the educational qualifications to be possessed by such person shall be Graduate from a recognised University or Institution.

However, such person shall not be required to qualify the test in Punjabi type-writing as provided in sub-rule (2)".

3. In the said rules, after rule 15, rule 15A shall be inserted namely :-

"15A. Minimum Educational and other Qualifications for appointment to the post of Senior Scale Stenographer by –

Direct appointment	Promotion
No person shall be given direct appointment to the post of Senior Scale Stenographer under the Punjab Government unless he –	i) From amongst the Junior Scale Stenographers, who have an experience of working as such for a minimum period of one year.
(i) Possesses the Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University or Institution; and	Provided that if the Junior Scale Stenographer is not available then from amongst the Steno typists, who have an experience of working as such for a minimum period of five years; and
(ii) Qualifies in a Stenography test in four paras (two in Punjabi and two in English language) containing 250 words each as follows :-	ii) Qualifies in a Stenography test in four paras (two in Punjabi and two in English language) containing 250 words each as follows:-

**No. G.S.R. 8/C.A.63/1948/S.112/Amd./2015.**-The following draft of rules further to amend the Punjab Factory Rules, 1952, which the Governor of Punjab proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 112 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act No. 63 of 1948), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, is published as required by sub-section (1) of section 115 of the said Act, for information of the persons likely to be affected thereby.

Notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration by the Government on or after the expiry of a period of forty-five days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette, together with any objection or suggestion, which may be received by the Chief Inspector of Factories, Punjab, S.C.O. No. 87-88, Sector 17-D, Chandigarh, from any person with respect to the said draft, before the expiry of the period so specified, namely :-

**DRAFT RULES**

1. These rules may be called the Punjab Factory (Amendment) Rules, 1952.
2. In the Punjab Factory Rules, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 8,—
  - (i) In sub rule (1), for the words "one year or five years" the words "one year or any further period upto ten years" shall be substituted; and
  - (ii) in sub rule (2),—
    - (a) for the words "five years," and "five times", the words "more than one year" and "multiplied by the number of years, "shall respectively be substituted;
    - (b) for the existing Schedule, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely :-

3. In the said rules, in rule 10, in sub-rule (2), for the words "one year or five years" the words "one year or any further period upto ten years" shall be substituted.
