**No. G.S.R.54/Const./Art.309 and S.80/P.A.10/2008/Amd.(1)/2016.-**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India readwith section 80 of the Punjab Police Act, 2007 (Punjab Act No. 10 of 2008), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Punjab Intelligence Cadre (Group 'C') Service Rules, 2015, namely: -

**RULES**

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Intelligence Cadre (Group 'C') Service (First Amendment) Rules, 2016.  
(2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Punjab Intelligence Cadre (Group 'C') Service Rules, 2015, in Appendix 'B, in Serial Nos. 1 and 4, under the headings titled as '*Method of appointment, experience and qualification for appointment*', under sub-heading '*by direct appointment*', for items (a) and (b), the following items shall, respectively, be substituted, namely: -

"(a) Should be a graduate from a recognized university or institution, as the case may be, provided that such candidate shall also possess an 'O' Level Certificate of Information Technology from the Department of Electronics Accreditation of Computer Course (DOEACC) or National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) or its equivalent institution recognized by the Government of India or any State Government;

OR

(b) B.Sc/B.Tech/B.E. in Information Technology or Computer Science or Information Systems or B.C.A. or Post Graduate Diploma in

Computer Applications from a recognized university or institution,  
as the case may be."
